Flagship Facility Open Q4 2019

Span Alaska is proud to announce its 54,000-square-foot Anchorage Service Center (ASC) is now open. Our new ASC is conveniently located near the Ted Stevens International Airport, and will function as Span Alaska's main service center for commercial goods from the lower 48, transported through the Port of Alaska into Anchorage and throughout the state.

The facility has an 8,100-square-foot covered area to protect flatbed freight loads, a larger loading dock, and improved security. This new operations center is purpose-built to improve customer experience, streamline freight handling, and enable faster delivery of cargo to its final destination.

Span Alaska is the largest freight carrier and forwarder in the state, delivering more than 400 million pounds of cargo annually through its highway, rail, air, and ocean network connecting the Lower 48 to all points in Alaska.

With its dedicated fleet of more than 500 trucks, containers, trailers, and flatbeds, Span maintains complete chain of custody and visibility throughout the freight move, from cargo receipt to doorstep delivery.
